Contest Rules

Design

- Designs must be completed using official template available at the library (334 Kent Street) or online at pdl.michlibrary.org/stickercontest.
- Designs MUST include the phrase “I checked out my library” or “I ✓’d out my library”.
- Artwork must be original, non-AI generated, and not contain copyrighted or trademarked designs.

Entry

- Entries must be submitted by Tuesday, December 30 at 11:59 p.m. Entries can be turned in at the library or emailed to cgrimminck@portlandmilibrary.com.
- Entries must include:
 - Entrant’s first and last name
 - Entrant’s age
 - Entrant’s phone number
- A maximum of two entries per person will be allowed.

Finalists and winners

- Finalists will be selected by library staff. Up to two winners will be chosen from the finalists by public vote. Voting will occur online January 12 – 25, and can be done online or in person at the library.
- Winners will be announced in February. The winning designs will be featured in the library, and winners will receive a Target gift card and a supply of stickers.

Tips and Suggestions

- Entries can be created using your preferred method (digital, paint, crayon, mixed media, etc.).
- If submitting your entry via email, provide as high quality resolution as possible.
- Most importantly, be creative and have fun!
